



AMENDED REQUEST FOR APPEAL Docket No. 2369-92

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to prior correspondence regarding the above subject docket number.

Officially we request a concurrent appeal hearing in Casper, Wyoming with Garlick Sales, Docket No. 2365-92.

Although I did not point it out in my angry response of March 20, 1992 we have followed the request of Bob Lucht of D.E.Q. in that we plugged off the sumps and consequently are not discharging anything into the septic tank or leaching field. This was done approximately mid August, 1991 or shortly after Lucht's visit on August 5th. Since that time we have injected compressed air into the septic tank and it is dry. There is no way to take a sample for testing from the "industrial drain field" as requested.

Essentially we have been precluded from using the facility as intended thus causing severe financial hardship on this company.
