

MOTION TO APPROVE THE JOINT STIPULATION TO MODIFY ADMINISTRATIVE  
ORDER ON CONSENT

The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (Department), moves the Wyoming Environmental Quality Council (Council) to approve the *Joint Stipulation to Modify Administrative Order on Consent* filed with the Council on February 18, 2015. The Department issued the original Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) to the City of Sundance (City) with consent of the City on January 5, 2012. The original purpose of the AOC was to bring the City into compliance with applicable permit requirements and to achieve closure of the facility. The Department and the City now seek to amend the AOC to establish a schedule for the City to take specific actions related to its enrollment in the Cease and Transfer Program (W.S. 35-11-528 through W.S. 35-11-532).

WHEREFORE, the Department requests that the Council approve the *Joint Stipulation to Modify Administrative Order on Consent*.


