NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND ORDER

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:**

1. The Town of Frannie (Frannie) is the owner of a waste water treatment facility in Wyoming which is permitted to discharge through the Wyoming Pollution Discharge Elimination System permit WY0020052.
2. Part I of the above referenced permit, under the Monitoring and Reporting section, requires effluent monitoring results to be summarized and reported on a Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) form. The WQD sent a Letter of Violation (LOV) to Frannie on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2007 instructing them to send in all delinquent DMRs to the WQD. The WQD did not receive a response to the LOV and did not receive any delinquent DMRs.
3. Frannie does not have a current chief operator for their waste water treatment facility.
4. This Notice is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c)(i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible;

**WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**


1. Frannie shall immediately submit complete and accurate delinquent DMRs to the WQD. This information shall be received by the WQD no later than 60 days after the receipt of the NOV by Frannie.
2. Frannie shall submit to the WQD a plan of action to ensure all DMRs are filled out correctly and submitted in at timely manner in the future.
3. Frannie shall have a certified operator of its waste water treatment facility by July 1, 2008.

This ORDER is final unless, no later than ten (10) days after the date this notice is received; it is appealed by filing two written requests for a hearing before the Environmental Quality Council. If a hearing is requested, the first hearing petition shall be mailed to the Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Council, Room 1714 Herschler Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor West, 122 West 25<sup>th</sup> St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The second petition shall be mailed to the Director, Wyoming Department of the Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor West, 122 West 25<sup>th</sup> St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.


