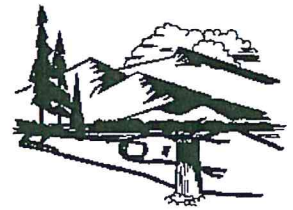

SUBJECT: Notice of Final Adoption of Water Quality Rules: Chapters 15 and 25

Please consider this memorandum as notice of final adoption of revised Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. Chapter 15, Standards for the Use or Surface Disposal of Biosolids; and Chapter 25, Septic Tanks, Soil Absorption Systems, and Other Small Wastewater Systems were modified in response to Governor Mead's streamlining government initiative. The revisions streamlined the Water Quality Rules and Regulations by moving the contents of Chapter 15, Appendix C to Chapter 25, new Appendix B; by repealing the remainder of Chapter 15; and by updating design requirements and correcting inconsistencies in Chapter 25. A copy of Chapter 25 and a copy of the certification page are enclosed.

The Environmental Quality Council adopted the revised rules at a public hearing at Casper College, Strausner Hall, Room SH 217, 125 College Drive, Casper, Wyoming on June 15, 2016. The final rule was filed with the Wyoming Secretary of State on July 27, 2016.
