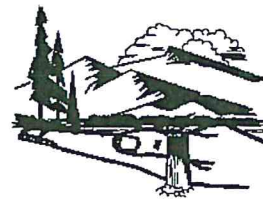

**SUBJECT:** Amended Proposed Rules: Rules of Practice and Procedure, Docket 16-1101

Per the January 19, 2017, hearing of Docket 16-1101, the Department of Environmental Quality is submitting a compiled list of changes and corrections, as discussed at the January 19<sup>th</sup> hearing, for the Council's consideration as proposed revisions to the Rules of Practice and Procedure.

On February 7, 2017, via telephone, Executive Secretary Jim Ruby confirmed that the Council does not have any additional comments to add to those that arose during the January 19 hearing.

The enclosed summary notes whether the proposed changes came from our discussion with the Council or whether they came out of our preparations for the January hearing. We are also enclosing revised chapters that include all of the proposed revisions noted in the summary for Chapter 1, clean version; Chapter 1, strike and underline version; Chapter 2, clean version; Chapter 2, strike and underline version; Chapter 3, strike and underline version; Chapter 5, strike and underline version, Chapter 7, strike and underline version; Chapter 9, clean version; and Chapter 9, strike and underline version.

These proposed amendments incorporate all of the changes discussed at the January hearing. I recommend adoption of the Rules of Practice and Procedure as amended.
