PUBLIC NOTICE

Mullinax Concrete Service Co., Inc. of Sheridan, Wyoming has applied for a small mining permit from the Land Quality Division of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality. The mining permit area for the mining of sand and gravel will be located in SE¼NW¼, NE¼SW¼, and NW¼SE¼, T55N, R85W, Section 19, Sheridan County, Wyoming. The area is approximately 11 miles west of Sheridan, Wyoming off Big Goose Canyon Road. The proposed operation is scheduled to begin in June of 2017 and is estimated to continue until an unknown date. The land, after mining, will be returned to agricultural use. Information regarding the proposed mining operation and reclamation procedures may be reviewed at the Cheyenne or Sheridan Office of the Land Quality Division, the office of Mullinax Concrete Service Co., Inc. or the Sheridan County Clerk's Office in Sheridan, Wyoming.

Upon request by an interested party, the Land Quality Division may schedule an informal conference to discuss the application. If such a meeting is scheduled, it must be prior to the date for the close of public comments. If concerns about the permit are not resolved by the Land Quality Division, written objections to the proposed mining operation must be received by the Administrator of the Land Quality Division of the Department of Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, WY 82002, before the close of business 30 days after the last publication. If an objection is submitted a public hearing shall be held within twenty (20) days after the final date for filing objections unless a different period is stipulated to by the parties. The Council or Director shall publish notice of the time, date and location of the hearing or conference in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed operation once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks immediately prior to the hearing or conference. The hearing shall be conducted as a contested case in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act (W.S. §16-3-101 through §16-3-115), and the right of judicial review shall be afforded as provided in that act. All parties as given in W.S. §13-11-406(j) will be mailed a copy of this notice. The Wyoming Oil and Gas Commission will be mailed a copy of the application mine plan map as required by W.S. §35-11-406(j).
