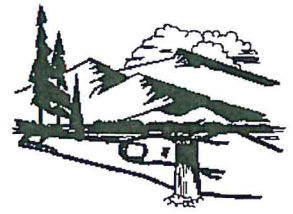

SUBJECT: Hearing Request for Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 14

The Water Quality Division of the Department of Environmental Quality is proposing revisions to Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 14 and is requesting the Environmental Quality Council review the proposal and consider adoption of these rules at your December 5, 2017 hearing.

The proposed rule was presented to the Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) at the June 23, 2017 meeting and the WWAB recommended approval of the proposed rule with minor revisions. The Governor's Office has approved proceeding with the proposed rule.
