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**PETITIONER'S EXPERT WITNESS DESIGNATION**

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Petitioner, Black Hills Bentonite, LLC (BHB or Petitioner), by undersigned counsel and pursuant to the Scheduling Order provides the following expert witness designation, subject to Petitioner's objection to relevancy and admissibility for the following reasons.

This proceeding is for an Order in lieu of Landowner Consent pursuant to W.S. §35-11-406(b)(xii). The requirements necessary to satisfy Petitioner's request are limited to those set forth in the statute, which include the following:

(A) That the mining plan and the reclamation plan have been submitted to the surface owner for approval;

(B) That the mining plan and the reclamation plan is detailed so as to illustrate the full proposed surface use including proposed routes of egress and ingress;

(C) That the use does not substantially prohibit the operations of the surface owner;

(D) The proposed plan reclaims the surface to its approved future use, in segments if circumstances permit, as soon as feasibly possible;

Respondents acknowledge that they own no minerals within the area of the Herco Amendment. (Response, ¶ 3) ("TTT Ranch Company and Crossingham do not own any mineral rights in any lands within the proposed Herco Amendment Area."). Yet, Respondents argue that Petitioner has no right to mine bentonite within the area of the Herco Amendment. While Petitioner believes that such issues are beyond the scope of the requirements in the statute, irrelevant, and should not be considered at the hearing, Petitioner has, out of an abundance of caution, provided a report by Alan Rabinoff to address Respondent's defense to the Order in the event the Council decides to entertain such a defense.

Wherefore, subject to the above objection, Petitioner submits the following report by Alan Rabinoff.

**Black Hills Bentonite Permit to Mine No. 248C (Herco Amendment)**  
**Report Prepared by Alan Rabinoff**

**Purpose of this Report**

I have prepared this report in order to document my expected testimony at the administrative hearing in Cheyenne, Wyoming, on or about February 22, 2018 before the Environmental Quality Council, State of Wyoming regarding the Black Hills Bentonite (BHB) Permit to Mine No. 248C (Herco amendment).

**Pertinent Experience of Alan Rabinoff**

In January 2008, I retired from a 32-year career with the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM). Shortly after that time and currently, I have been working as a consultant. My experience in work related to federal lands and associated mining exceeds forty-one (41) years.

BLM

During my tenure at BLM, I served as a geologist in Rock Springs, Wyoming, Montrose, Colorado and Phoenix Arizona; branch chief of mining law administration in Phoenix; branch chief of solid minerals in Salt Lake City, Utah; and as deputy state director, minerals and lands in Cheyenne, Wyoming. After training and practical experience, I also became a BLM-certified mineral examiner. With that certification, I testified as an expert witness on behalf of the United States at an administrative hearing before the Department of the Interior, Office of Hearings and Appeals, to determine the validity of mining claims. In this venue, I stated my opinion as to whether such mining claims met all federal regulatory requirements for location and discovery of a valuable mineral deposit under the general mining law of 1872, as amended.

As deputy state director in Wyoming, I oversaw the mining law administration staff, responsible for adjudicating all required document filings in the BLM Wyoming State Office for mining claims in the state.

During my BLM career, I co-authored the current BLM regulations on the surface management of mining claims (43 Code of Federal Regulations Subpart 3809). Under the authority of these regulations, I was responsible for developing and implementing a 2003 memorandum of understanding (MOU) between the BLM and the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division. This MOU governed the respective roles of the two agencies in managing mining-claim operations on federal lands in Wyoming.

1 Consultant

2 Since 2008, I have worked as a consultant both as an individual and as an employee of ICF,  
3 which is an international professional-services consulting firm.

4  
5 As an individual, my experience includes advising energy companies and mining companies on  
6 how to comply with BLM requirements for projects on the ground. Between 2011 and 2012, I  
7 was deposed several times as an expert on BLM requirements. In addition, I testified before an  
8 arbitrator during title arbitration between two entities.

9  
10 As an ICF employee, I have served as a project manager, project director, and senior advisor,  
11 working with a team to prepare environmental impact statements (EISs) and environmental  
12 assessments (EAs) for the BLM and for the Forest Service. My ICF role requires that I have  
13 sufficient knowledge to ensure compliance with applicable BLM and Forest Service  
14 requirements and policies. This ensures that each agency, respectively, is able to make formal  
15 decisions that are based on environmental effects disclosed in these EISs and EAs.

16  
17 **Key Terms and Related Requirements**

18  
19 Based on my knowledge of applicable statutes, BLM regulations and BLM policies, I have  
20 summarized key terms and requirements immediately below (key terms underlined for  
21 emphasis).

22  
23 A mining claim confers a right against all others to mine, subject to statutory and regulatory  
24 limitations, within the confines of an area delineated by the locator(s). It is an assertion by the  
25 locator(s) that they have made a discovery, which is a physical exposure of a valuable mineral  
26 deposit, subject to exploration for- and mining, under the authority granted by general mining  
27 law of 1872, as amended. A valuable mineral deposit is one that would lead a prudent person  
28 to expend time and means with the reasonable expectation of developing a paying mine.

29  
30 The location date is critical in that it establishes this limited right to mine against other  
31 entrypersons (locators, mineral explorers, or permittees of the United States). Under BLM  
32 policy and all else being regular, a mining claim is valid unless and until it is declared otherwise  
33 by the United States Department of the Interior (DOI) in a final administrative decision or by a  
34 court of competent jurisdiction. In addition, a mining claim is void *ab initio* (from the beginning)  
35 in certain circumstances, such as an attempt to locate a mining claim on non-federal mineral  
36 estate or on federal mineral estate that is not open to exploration and mining under the mining  
37 laws.

38  
39 If a "junior" mining claim locator over-stakes and top-files a mining claim within some- or all of  
40 the area delineated by an existing "senior" mining claim, the senior mining claim locator is  
41 presumed to retain the right to mine against the junior locator. This stems from the fact that

1 the location date of the senior mining claim predates that of the junior mining claim, an  
2 example of "first in time, first in right." In order to supplant the senior mining claim locator's  
3 rights, the junior locator must prevail in a proceeding in a court of competent jurisdiction,  
4 alleging that the locator made a discovery before the senior locator.

5  
6 An active mining claim is listed as such in the BLM Legacy Rehost 2000 (LR2000) computer  
7 database. It is *prima facie* evidence that the BLM believes this mining claim has complied with  
8 all applicable regulatory filing requirements and filing deadlines. If a mining claim is not listed as  
9 "active" in LR2000, it is typically listed as "closed."

10  
11 A patent in the context of this report is a transfer of surface ownership interest from the United  
12 States to a U.S. citizen in compliance with the Stock Raising Homestead Act of 1916. Such  
13 patent reserved the rights of the United States or its permittees (entryperson in some cases),  
14 among other things, to enter upon the land to explore for minerals, locate mining claims, and  
15 use so much of the surface as is necessary incident to mining. Compensation by the  
16 entryperson is limited to damages to crops and tangible improvements.

17  
18 A Notice of Intent to Locate (NOITL) must be filed by an entryperson interested in exploring,  
19 then re-entering to locate a mining claim upon private surface first patented under the Stock  
20 Raising Homestead Act of 1916. A NOITL segregates the land from subsequent entry by would-  
21 be mining claim locators (other than the NOITL filer), preventing entry for mining-claim location  
22 purposes for a period of 90 days from the date that the BLM accepts the NOITL. A NOITL is not  
23 required to be filed with the BLM if the entryperson is the surface owner.

#### 24 25 **Land Status Within Project Area**

26  
27 The mine plan for permit to mine no. 248C – Herco Amendment (May 2017) prepared for BHB,  
28 LLC, (BHB) indicates that mining-related operations in the project or project area are proposed  
29 within Township 41 North, Range 81 West, 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Wyoming.

30  
31 The Herco Amendment covers Section 2: SE1/4SE1/4 and Section 11: E1/2.

#### 32 33 Section 2: SE1/4SE1/4, Section 11: NE1/4NE1/4

34 The land status records that I have examined include the Master Title Plat (MTP) for that  
35 township (see Figure 1 – Master Title Plat). The MTP indicates that Section 2: SE1/4SE1/4, and  
36 Section 11: NE1/4NE1/4 contain fee land, meaning that neither the surface nor mineral estate  
37 are in federal ownership. These parcels comprise the lands within the quitclaim deed from  
38 Herco Minerals to BHB (see BHB Exhibit 2 – Quitclaim Deed). See Figure 2 – Relative Positions  
39 of Mining Claims, NOITL and Fee land for representation of the relative positions of mining  
40 claims, Notice of Intent to Locate, and fee land discussed within this report.

41

1 Section 11: NW1/4NE1/4, S1/2NE1/4

2 The MTP (Figure 1) indicates that the surface of these lands was transferred by the United  
3 States into private ownership via patent number 1099476 (covering the NW1/4NE1/4) and  
4 patent number 1082651 (including the S1/2NE1/4). All minerals, as well as the rights to ditches  
5 and canals, were reserved to the United States, meaning the mineral estate is managed by the  
6 BLM. These lands contain mining claim TTT#10 (BLM Serial Number WMC303691).

7  
8 Section 11: SE1/4

9 The MTP (see Figure 1) shows that the surface of this parcel was patented by the United States  
10 into private ownership via patent number 1082651. All minerals, as well as the rights to ditches  
11 and canals, were reserved to the United States. The SE¼ of Section 11 contains mining claim  
12 Bobcat #10 (BLM Serial Number WMC293763). The E1/2SE1/4 of Section 11 contains mining  
13 claim TTT 13-27 (BLM Serial Number WMC309575). The W1/2SE1/4 contains a NOITL (BLM  
14 Serial Number WYW186911) accepted by the BLM Wyoming State Office on December 15,  
15 2017. The land covered by the NOITL is segregated from new mineral entry and mining-claim  
16 location until March, 15, 2018.

17  
18 **Mining Claims in the Project Area**

19  
20 On January 12, 2018, I examined copies of the official BLM records for the mining claims in the  
21 project area, sent by the BLM Wyoming State Office to BHB counsel. The following summarizes  
22 the status of these mining claims.

23  
24 Bobcat #10 (WMC293763)

25 Location date: May 18, 2008

26 Case disposition: Active (see Attachment 1 – Serial Register Page WMC293763 from LR2000)

27  
28 TTT #10 (WMC303691)

29 Location date: January 24, 2011

30 Case disposition: Active (see Attachment 2 – Serial Register Page WMC303691 from LR2000)

31  
32 TTT 13-27 (WMC309575)

33 Location date: May 23, 2013

34 Case disposition: Active (see Attachment 3 – Serial Register Page WMC309575 from LR2000)

35 TTT 13-27 appears to have been top-filed over the entire east half of the Bobcat #10 mining  
36 claim.

37  
38 **Notice of Intent to Locate (NOITL) in the Project Area**

39  
40 The following summarizes the status of the NOITL filed on lands in the project area.

1 Date case established by BLM: December 15, 2017 (see Attachment 4 – Serial Register Page  
2 WYW186911 from LR2000)  
3 Date land segregated from mining-claim locations: December 16, 2017  
4 Date land segregation terminates: March 15, 2018  
5 Case disposition: Pending  
6 Note: The area described in this NOITL overlaps the entire west half of the Bobcat #10 mining  
7 claim.

### 9 Conclusion(s)

10

11 Based on my review of available records, as well as my knowledge and experience, I conclude  
12 the following:

13

- 14 1. The Bobcat #10 mining claim is active and valid, with discovery of a valuable mineral  
15 deposit asserted on May 18, 2008, the location date.
- 16 2. The TTT #10 mining claim is active and valid, with discovery of a valuable mineral  
17 deposit asserted on January 24, 2011, the location date.
- 18 3. The TTT 13-27 mining claim is active, per BLM records. Discovery of a valuable mineral  
19 deposit has been asserted on May 23, 2013, the location date.
- 20 4. The TTT 13-27 mining claim is a junior mining claim relative to the Bobcat #10.
- 21 5. In order to sustain mining-claim rights on the TTT 13-27 that supplant those of the  
22 Bobcat #10 mining claim, the TTT 13-27 mining-claim owner must be able to  
23 demonstrate the following:
  - 24 a. that the upon the location date of May 23, 2013, the locators had discovered a  
25 valuable mineral deposit,
  - 26 b. that a discovery also existed on August 1, 2013, the date that the original TTT 13-  
27 27 co-locators assigned ownership to the current mining-claim owner, and,
  - 28 c. that the locators of the Bobcat #10 mining claim failed to make a discovery on  
29 May 18, 2008, the location date of that mining claim.
- 30 6. The Bobcat #10 mining claim has an exclusive, limited right to mine, against the locators  
31 of the TTT 13-27 mining claim, and others.
- 32 7. The Bobcat #10 mining claim has an exclusive, limited right to mine, against locators of  
33 any junior mining claim that subsequently has been- or will be located on the same  
34 parcel of land described in the NOITL addressed in this report.


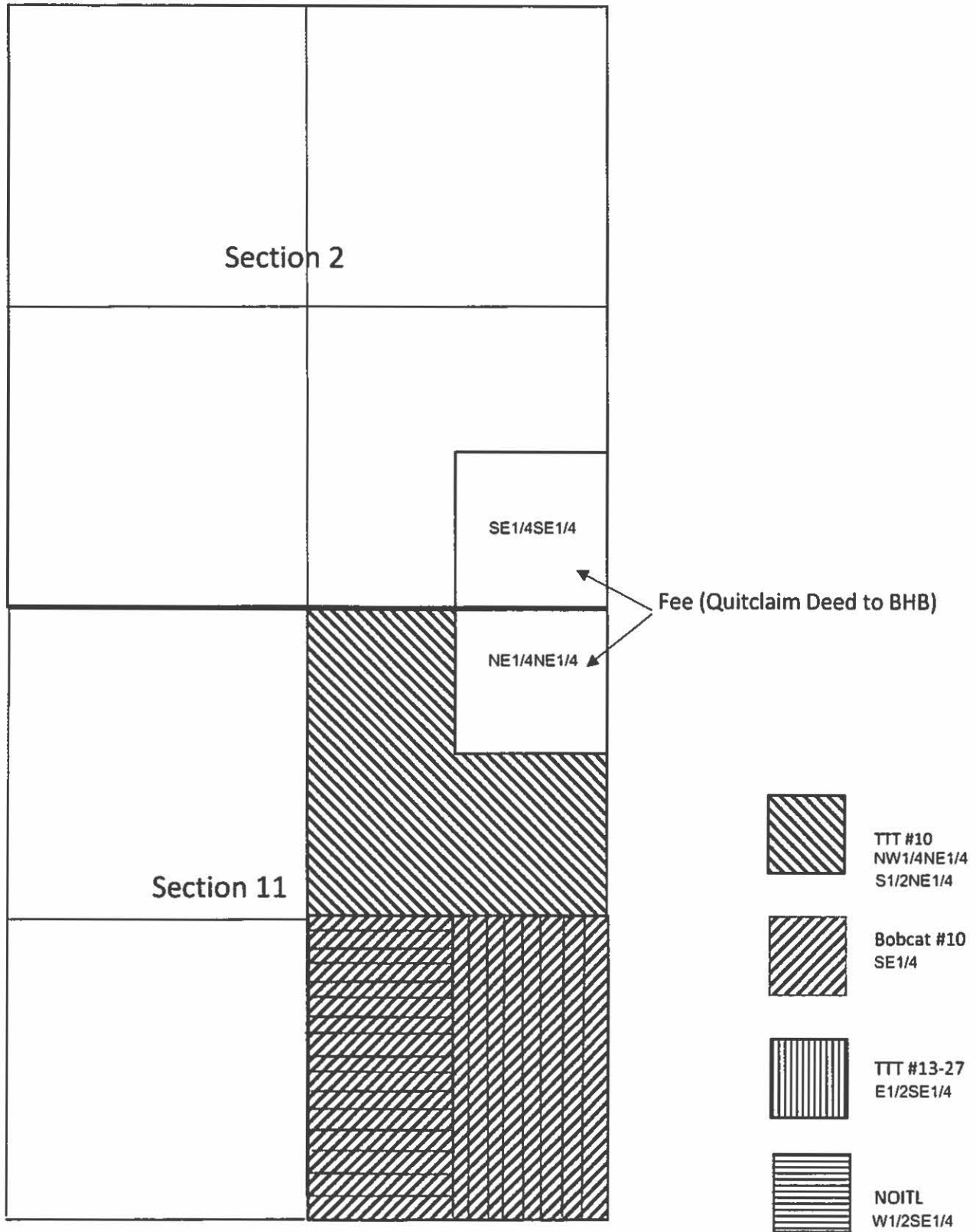
