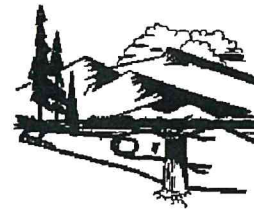

**SUBJECT:** Proposed Rules for Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality, Chapter 3

**DATE:** March 21, 2022

**PRIORITY:** HIGH—Deadline for response is **April 4, 2022**

**SUMMARY:** The Department is proposing to amend Water Quality Rules Chapter 3, Regulations for Permit to Construct, Install or Modify Public Water Supplies, Wastewater Facilities, Disposal Systems, Biosolids Management Facilities, Treated Wastewater Reuse Systems and Other Facilities Capable of Causing or Contributing to Pollution, by adding an exclusion for coal combustion residual (CCR) surface impoundments that will be permitted by the Solid Waste Program once the new Solid Waste Rules CCR chapter is adopted and signed by the Governor, and by correcting cross-reference errors, minor grammar errors, and formatting errors. Specific information on the changes can be found in the Statement of Principal Reasons.
