**ORDER SETTING HEARING ON MOTIONS TO DISMISS**

This matter came before the Council on the Department's Motion to Dismiss and Supplemental Motion to Dismiss, and Basecamp's Motion to Dismiss; and the Council having considered the same and being fully advised, hereby finds said matter should be set for a hearing.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that a hearing on the motions to dismiss is hereby scheduled for October 23, 2024 beginning at 1:00 p.m. The hearing will be held in Cheyenne, WY at the Hathaway Building Room 127, and will be available remotely through Google Meet. Invitations to the hearing will be sent by Council staff to all parties and will be available on the Council's public website. Anyone requiring assistance connecting to this hearing may contact Business Officer Coordinator Joe Girardin at 307-777-7170.

The Department will have up to ten (10) minutes to address the Council on its motion, to include any time reserved for rebuttal. Protect Our Water Jackson Hole (POWJH) will have up to ten (10) minutes to respond to the Department's argument. Basecamp will then have up to ten (10) minutes to address the Council on its motion, to include any time reserved for rebuttal. POWJH will have up to ten (10) minutes to respond to Basecamp's argument.

As authorized under the Council's contested case rules, the parties may file any supplemental memoranda to these motions by October 7, 2024. See *Rules*, DEQ, Practice and Procedure, Contested Case Hearings, Chapter 2, § 11(a).
