Notice of Final Adoption of Air Quality Rules: Chapters 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 11 and 14

(R-37)

Please consider this memorandum as notice of final adoption of revised air quality standards and regulations. Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations (WAQSR), Chapters 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 11, and 14 have been revised in this rulemaking, and changes became effective on December 27, 2024. Please discard the existing contents of Chapters 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 11, and 14, and then insert the new editions of the chapter, which also can be accessed electronically at https://rules.wyo.gov/Default.aspx. The revised chapter includes a foreword, table of contents and body of regulations.

Chapter 2, Ambient Standards, Section 2, Ambient Standards for Particulate Matter, has been updated to reflect the newly promulgated PM_{2.5} National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). Section 12, Incorporation by Reference, has been updated to incorporate by reference from the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) as of July 1, 2024. The revisions to Sections 2 and 12 involve changes to the State Implementation Plan (SIP).

Chapter 3, General Emission Standards, Section 9, Incorporation by Reference, has been updated to incorporate by reference from the CFR as of July 1, 2024. There is one additional, non-substantive revision in Chapter 3, Section 8, pertaining to a typographical revision. The revisions to Section 9 involve changes to the SIP.

Chapter 4, State Performance Standards for Specific Existing Sources, Section 6, Incorporation by Reference, has been updated to incorporate by reference from the CFR as of July 1, 2024.

Chapter 5, National Emission Standards, Section 2, New Source Performance Standards, has been updated to incorporate 40 CFR Part 60, subpart UU, which pertains to standards of performance for asphalt processing and asphalt roofing manufacture and storage, and 40 CFR Part 60, subpart OOOOb, which pertains to standards of performance for crude oil and natural gas facilities that commenced construction, modification, or reconstruction after
