About half of our ranch is covered with Methane water of which is a big asset to our land & to our live stock and wildlife.

The Quality of water discharged from Methane wells is of good quality. In fact ~~we~~ <sup>my family</sup> have been drinking it for 54 yrs and doing fine. Water Quality people tell us that the Methane Water is better than our well we use for our homes.

Using this good water has allowed us to put Mt. goaves on our livestock and has help us utilize forage that needs to be used each yr, this is a lesser quality grass & there for ~~we~~ need to get rid of it.

With 8 Miles of creek bottom that has Methane water running the length of that area we have no sign of Salt on the Surface. The many Water <sup>ways</sup> Reservoirs are a great asset to our land.

We are comfortable with the rules as they stand.
