Dear Mr. Ruby,

I am planning to be in Cheyenne when the EQC's hears my Petition for Rehearing. on May 14, 2010. I thank Council for the opportunity to speak further to this matter.

My understanding from the EQC Hearing Order filed April 9, 2010, is that Parties will present their arguments for why or why not they believe that the hearing should be reopened, that each party will have ten minutes to present their case, and that Council will hear these arguments and decide either at the meeting or later whether or not to reopen the hearing, such a reopening, if it is to occur, to be scheduled to take place at a future date. If I have misunderstood either the format or the scope of the hearing of my April 1, 2010 Petition for Rehearing to take place on May 14, 2010, would you please let me know.
