The Mountain Cement Company of Laramie, Wyoming has filed a mining permit amendment application with the Land Quality Division of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality for the mining of limestone in Albany County, Wyoming. The Etchepare Limestone Quarry Amendment Area is approximately 8.6 miles southeast of Laramie, Wyoming and south of Interstate 80. The application may be viewed at the Cheyenne Office of the Land Quality Division. The application will be readvertised for public comment prior to approval by the Department of Environmental Quality. Any interested parties are encouraged to review the application and contact the appropriate Land Quality Division District Supervisor with questions about the application. Upon request by an interested party, the Land Quality Division may schedule a public meeting to discuss the application.
