The Wyoming Environmental Quality Council (EQC) will consider proposed revisions to Chapter 1 and the creation of Chapter 17 of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ), Solid and Hazardous Waste Division's (SHWD), Solid Waste Rules and Regulations at a public hearing to be held on February 25-26, 2014, in the University of Wyoming Union/University Building, 951 North Poplar Street, Casper, WY 82601. The SHWD, pursuant to the authority vested in it by the Environmental Quality Act, Wyoming Statute §35-11-503, proposed to amend and revise Chapter 1 and create Chapter 17 of the Solid Waste Rules and Regulations. The revisions to Chapter 1 are intended to incorporate provisions for the administration of the Cease and Transfer Program established pursuant to Wyoming Statute §35-11-528 through 532 and create Chapter 17 to implement the Wyoming Leaking Landfill Remediation Program (Remediation Program) established pursuant to Wyoming Statute §35-11-533 through 537. Chapter 1 provides the definitions and general requirements for solid waste permits in Wyoming. Chapter 17 establishes the eligibility and program requirements for the Remediation Program. The EQC is accepting comments on the proposed revisions beginning December 27, 2013. The written comment period ends at 5:00 PM MST on February 10, 2014. Comments must be written and signed by the commenter. Comments are to be sent to the following address: WDEQ/Solid and Hazardous Waste Division, 122 West 25th Street, Herschler Building, 4W, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. SHWD will file a response to comments with the EQC and post those on the SHWD's website <http://deq.state.wy.us> prior to the EQC's February 25-26, 2014, hearing. The proposed rule package, comments submitted, and the response to comments will be posted on the EQC's website (<http://eqc.state.wy.us/docket.htm>) under the link titled "13-5102" as they are received. On February 25-26, 2014, the EQC will consider the proposed rules, written

comments, and the response to comments along with any modifications proposed to the draft rules. At the public hearing, oral statements that focus on the written comments and WDEQ's response to comments will be accepted.

The EQC will determine if the record will remain open beyond the close of the scheduled hearing. The EQC may close the record and make a final decision at the conclusion of the comments. As such, those wishing to comment on the proposed revisions should submit comments according to the schedule above. Any person wishing to use a digital presentation during their testimony before the EQC must provide a digital copy to the EQC no less than 3 days prior to the hearing unless you contact the EQC and request an extension for good cause. Failure to submit a timely digital copy will result in the person not being allowed to use the presentation during their testimony.
