

THIS IS A PETITION RELATING TO THE COAL DUST POLLUTION AND BLASTING DAMAGES IN AND AROUND THE HANNA AREA--

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

We, the undersigned citizens, of the Hanna area, Carbon County Wyoming, ask your help in the matter of stopping the Energy Development Company, located in Hanna, Wyoming from continuing to destroy our health and our property. We ask that their coal crusher, conveyor, and transfer point be moved far enough outside of the community, so that the coal dust from this operation will not be blown unto our property. We also object to this air pollution for respiratory reasons.

We ask also, that the problem of the excessive blasting, which is damaging our property, be investigated and stopped immediatly.

Copies of this petition will be sent to various agencies and representatives, to ask for help in determining what regulations are being violated and what can be done about this very serious matter.

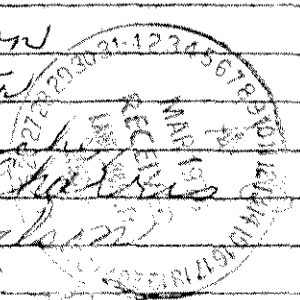
