## MOTION OF CORDERO MINING CO., INC. TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW, Cordero Mining Co., Inc., ("Cordero"), by and through its attorneys, Vines, Rideout, Gusea & White, P.C., Cheyenne, Wyoming, and moves the Environmental Quality Council for permission to intervene in the above-referenced matter for the limited purpose of cross-examination, argument and submitting a brief and memorandum of points and authorities on the legal issues presented as they may affect Cordero in this or subsequent proceedings, and in support of this motion, states as follows:

- 1. This Motion to Intervene is made pursuant to The Department of Environmental Quality, Rules of Practice and Procedure (1982), Chapter II, §7(a) and (b).
- 2. The motion for intervention anticipates participation by Cordero in a limited capacity for the purpose of conducting and cross-examination of the witnesses submitted, argument by counsel for Cordero, and submission of a legal brief and memorandum of points and authorities to the Council to the extent that the legal issues in the above-referenced matter are similar to the legal issues presented in THE MATTER OF A PERMIT APPLICATION FROM THE CARTER MINING COMPANY TO MODIFY THE CARTER CABALLO MINE IN CAMPBELL COUNTY, WYOMING, Docket No. 1723-86.

Cordero is a party to the latter action and to the extent that any legal rulings or decisions are made in this action that might effect the Carter Mining Permit Application, Cordero will be adversely affected by this action and the rulings made by the Council.

- 3. In addition, Cordero believes that while the legal issues will be adequately placed before the Council, the additional participation of Cordero in the limited capacity noted would be of benefit to the Council and to the ultimate decision, as well as allowing Cordero to adequately protect its interests in this and subsequent proceedings. Without such participation, Cordero believes it will be prejudiced.
- 4. Notice has been given to all the parties in this action in a timely fashion under the rules and regulations.

WHEREFORE, Cordero Mining Co., respectfully requests an Order of the Council allowing it to intervene in the above matter for the purpose of cross-examination, argument and submission of a legal brief or memorandum on the disputed issues of law.
