AGREEMENT BETWEEN APPLICANT AND
THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
QUALITY, LAND QUALITY DIVISION

This Agreement is entered into pursuant to paragraph 2 of the order of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order of the Environmental Quality Council signed on June 3, 1982.

1. This Agreement is conditioned upon approval and acceptance by the Environmental Quality Council. Applicant filed a petition for review and a motion for rehearing on the order entered herein. Should this Agreement be adopted by the Council and accepted as containing the only conditions attached to the permit, Applicant will cause the petition for review and motion for rehearing to be dismissed.

2. Applicant agrees to control dust as follows:

a. Applicant agrees to water the road during its usage as reasonably required.

3. Applicant agrees to maintain cattleguards regularly during the times it uses the road. After each season during which Applicant uses of the road, it will clean under the cattleguards and insure that cattleguards are adequately connected to the adjoining fence at both ends.

4. Applicant agrees to blade down the high spots adjacent to the road in the area pointed out and inspected by the staff engineer of the Land Quality Division and shown on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
