WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTION AND STIPULATED MOTION TO DISMISS

Philp Sheep Company filed an objection to the issuance of a mining permit to Rock Springs Mineral Processing. The hearing has been continued by the Wyoming Environmental Quality Council ("EQC"). Philp Sheep Company and Rock Springs Mineral Processing have entered into a Road Access Agreement which addresses the access by Rock Springs Mineral Processing across Philp Sheep Company real property. Based upon the Road Access Agreement, Philp Sheep Company withdraws its objection.

Based upon the agreement reached by the parties, all parties hereby stipulate and move the EQC for an order dismissing this matter.
